- 7) Gracie Jensen won the 200 m dash.

- 9) Hannah Arnold finished in 2nd place in the shot put.
- 10) Una Samoukovic was 1st place in the high jump and




The boys' track team defeated Hanover Central last night 79 to 17, winning every single scored event. Those earning points included:

- Richardson won the 100 in 13 flat with England 2nd in 13.9
- 1600 meter had Bowman 1st in 5:34 with Newton 2nd in 5:59
- Mercer was the 400 champ in 63 seconds
- The 400 relay team of Richardson, England, Blair, and Kwiathowski won in 51 seconds
- Flyin' Patrick Ryan won the 800 in 2:36
