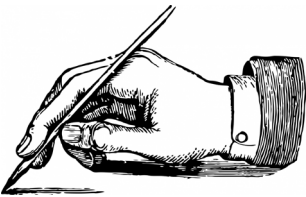

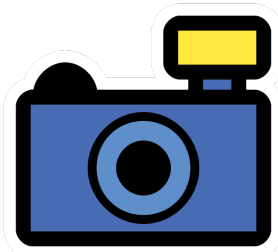


Mattress Sale

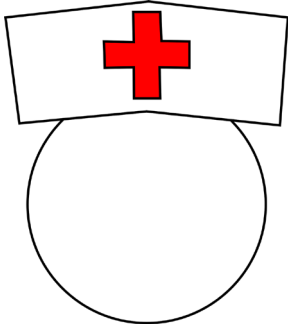
LOST AND FOUND
