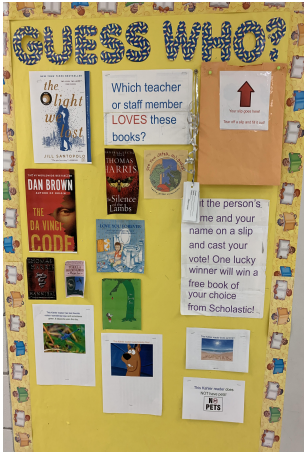

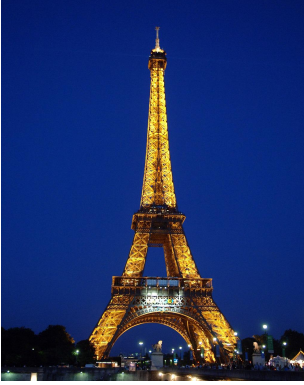

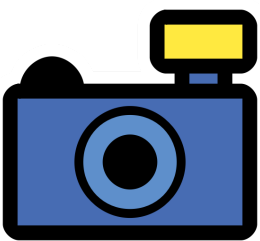
In order to travel students must meet the following criteria:

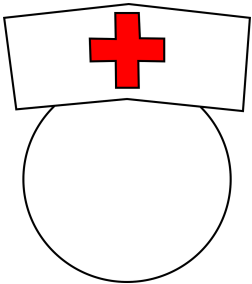
LOST AND FOUND
