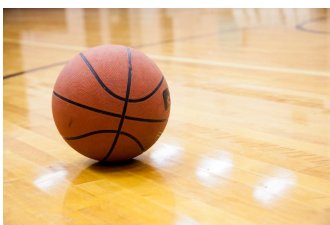

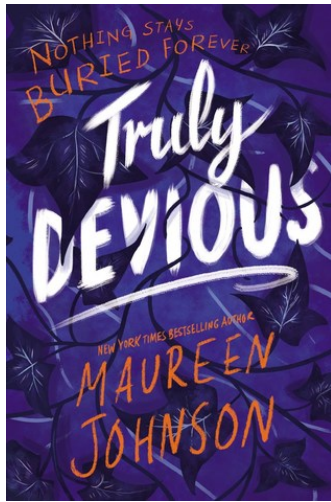
Kahler's Got Talent will take place Friday February 17th at 6:30pm in Kahler's Cafeteria - information for tickets to be released soon!

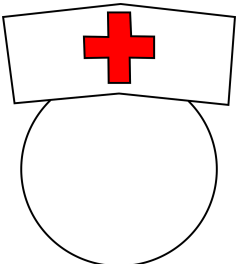
