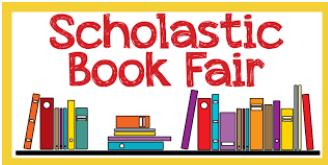

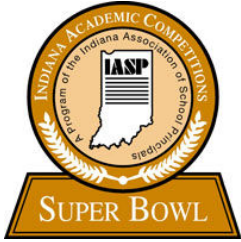
I'm excited to announce that our school will be hosting a Scholastic Book Fair, which will take place on **Monday, February 10th through Friday, February 14th**.
