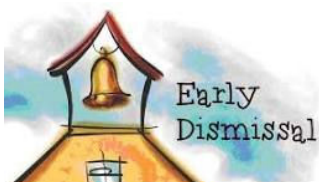
All students are required to have earbuds or headphones with wires at school.
