There will be a **SCIENCE OLYMPIAD** meeting Wednesday until 4:30 for clean up and Thursday until 5 for the end of the year celebration.



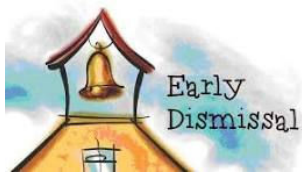
