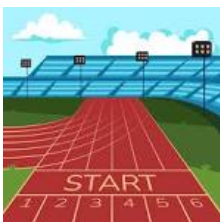

BOYS TRACK: Last night the boys' track team defeated Clark 63 to 41. Lots and lots of top times/distances turned in by our Kolts. A few—and only a few—of the meet highlights included:

- In the mile, the event champion was JC Baxter in 5:22. Runner-up was Julian Gomez in 5:39. And taking 3rd was Brigham Redhead in 5:43. Vince Alergia and Ethan Porter were also close in low six minute times.
- In the discus, Eddie Ramos is so close to 90 feet now. He was runner-up in 86 feet, 6.5 inches. Eddie was also tops for the Kolts in shot put with a nearly 28 feet throw—so close to the 30 foot mark!
- Hurdles, yet again, had three Kolts all under 18 seconds. Daniel Capehart was champion, Josh Arambula was second, and Blake Hambleton was third.
- In the 100, Homzie Wahdah was runner-up in 12.3. Runners Tzion Smothers and Jayden Baranski also broke 13 seconds.

- The 400 had Logan Bluett as champion in 61 seconds with Blake Hambleton runner-up in 62. Josh Arambula was the B race winner in 66 seconds.
- In the 800, the Kolts dominated, with several Kolts under 2:40. Sorry, no names as results are yet to be finished.
- In the 1600 relay, Kolts took complete control. No official results yet, but our Kolts took control early and all the Kolts relay squads ran fantastic.
